



Game Players Unlimited has operated successfully within the village of Brockport since 1999.

The store's primary business is in buying and selling second hand games and related equipment.

There will be no change in the way I have always conducted my business on North Main St.

My current hours have been almost unchanged for over a decade. After the move, I plan to adjust them based on volume. But the hours will look like something this:

Mon-Sat 11-7

Sun 12-5

I plan to run the store myself. However, I am seeking a person who can do repairs on gaming equipment.

There is a 5 yard dumpster in the back. I expect to have less waste than the tattoo place did. Hardly any work related waste really.

Depending on the season, we can have 3 customers a day or 50.

There is ample private parking in the rear, as well as public parking all around that you're familiar with. With the volume we expect to do, parking will never become an issue for us.

I don't get deliveries other than occasional postal and UPS packages.

There is only one industry related certificate that I am required to carry, and I do. Monroe County Pawn Law requires I register yearly with the County, and list all items over \$15 to leadsonline.com which is a database of second hand goods for the sake of reclaiming potentially stolen property. In the years since this has been in place, our store has never turned over merchandise due to theft through this system.

We can not in good faith profile people and assume any one customer is a thief. So we have always done every thing we can to scare them away, by doing these things(long before it was law):

- Requiring ID(and scanning them into our system) from an adult over 18 years of age, for cash buy backs.

- Requiring a signature stating these are their items to sell.

- Having cameras placed on the door, the register, and parking lot(to capture license plates). All video is stored on HDD for 20 something days.

- Most importantly we look everyone in the eye and ask if this is theirs.

Safety plans, lighting, exterior... this is all existing and wont be altered.

I would like to request signage for 3 sides of the building. The Main St side, the canal side, and the parking lot side. Also, I would like to request permission to place a small sign at the entrance to the parking lot with an arrow- something the size of a handicapped sign. Our private parking lot can be somewhat difficult for people to navigate even if they know where it is. But the parking lot is so valuable I would like to find every way to make it easier for our customers to utilize it.
