Minutes of 01/25/16: Motion by member Duff, second by member Kristansen, approved.

Discussion re: Sign Code draft #11

1. 43-10-B (1) should state "...shall not exceed two square feet...", "...public frontage for each use therein.", and should conclude with the following: "Businesses located adjacent to the canal may put one such sign on the façade facing the canal."
2. Temp Signs – use Ithaca’s definition, and remove definitions for construction, political, public service, real estate and any other temporary signs.
3. Human Person Signs – change his/her to “their”.
4. 43-7-B – change to allow 6 sq ft for residential and mixed use properties, 9 sq ft for non-residential business uses, and 15 sq ft for industrial uses.
5. Committee decided to allow CEO Miller to decide whether to use Ithaca’s definition of sign area, our revised definition, or our old definition of same.
6. Discussion of Café Permits: Though it might look nice, having tables and chairs next to the curb could expose people to car doors, cars coming over the curb, etc. We need to work carefully on language if we are going to expand what is currently allowed in order to mitigate liability. The committee decided to recommend no changes to the existing Café Permit code.

Motion to adjourn by Chair Appleby, seconded by member Graham. Adjourned at 7 pm. Next scheduled meeting March 28, 2016.
