Meeting July 19, 2012

The meeting was called to order at 7:17 with Bill Andrews chairing.

Andrews reported that no one had notified him of their inability to attend.

Designation of local landmarks is moving slowly. P. Ketchum will now do the Bucholz residence . Bill spoke to Art Bucholz who has expressed an interest in having it nominated. K. Goetz will take over the Hawken residence for Pam and will finish up the Panning- Rice home.

Bartos was enthusiastic about the designation of State St. and Park Ave as a historic district with the exclusion of the Dolan property at the corner of Union and Park. She feels that South St could be considered as part of this also. We also took her to see the High Street Cemetery which she felt could possibly be considered as a nomination in its own right.

Bill Andrews announced that with his election to the Village Board he will no longer chair the H P Board. K. Goetz who is serving as Vice -chair will become chair and B. Andrews will serve as the Vice-chair. This was moved by P. Ketchum, seconded by C. Moore and approved by the Board.

It was noted by B. Andrews that Lisa Bretton who lives on Holley St. is a grants writer should we need help writing grants. He also mentioned that there is a Civil War exhibit at the library and that there are Civil War vets buried at the High St. Cemetery.

Ketchum said that on Aug 25th college students will be working to clean up Corbett Park . She had thought that perhaps they could help do the same at the High St. Cemetery but had decide against that idea.
