- Amend fee schedule – (re permit fee for chickens) – As a follow up to Local Law #1-2019 adopted 4/15/19 amending Village Code Chapter 5: Animals as it relates to chickens:

→ Trustee LaPierre moved, Trustee Halquist seconded, carried 5/0 to amend the fee schedule to include a \$15 permit fee for chickens - renewable every 3 years.

- Amend fee schedule – (re Welcome Center rates for boats docking and using electric and/or water, etc.) – This was on the 4/15/19 agenda but was missed. Instead of a varied fee based on boat length, a \$15 flat fee was recommended by Welcome Center management.

→ Trustee LaPierre moved, Trustee Kristansen seconded, carried 5/0 to amend the fee schedule to a \$15 flat fee for the Welcome Center for boats docking and using electric and/or water, etc.
