**Village of Brockport Receives Grant for Concert Series;
Ruby Shooz, Local Talent Highlight 2008 Schedule**

The Village of Brockport's annual Summer Serenades Concert Series, which will kick off Thursday June 12th with a performance from the Brockport High School groups *Mad Vocals & The Triple Quartet*, will again be underwritten this year with recently announced grant support from the Community Foundation of Rochester.

For the second straight year, the Village was awarded \$2,000 towards the operation of the popular summer music series through the Community Foundation's Community Enrichment Fund.

The concert series will see a few changes this year. Concerts will be held on Thursday nights from June 12th-August 21st with performances from 6:30 pm until 8 pm. June and July concerts will be held at Sagawa Park, 96 Main Street with the August shows switching venues to the Welcome Center at Harvester Park, 11 Water Street.

A mainstay attraction for area residents for many years, the Summer Serenades Concert Series in Downtown Brockport regularly attract hundreds of people to Brockport's historic commercial district in a family-friendly showcase of local musical talent.
