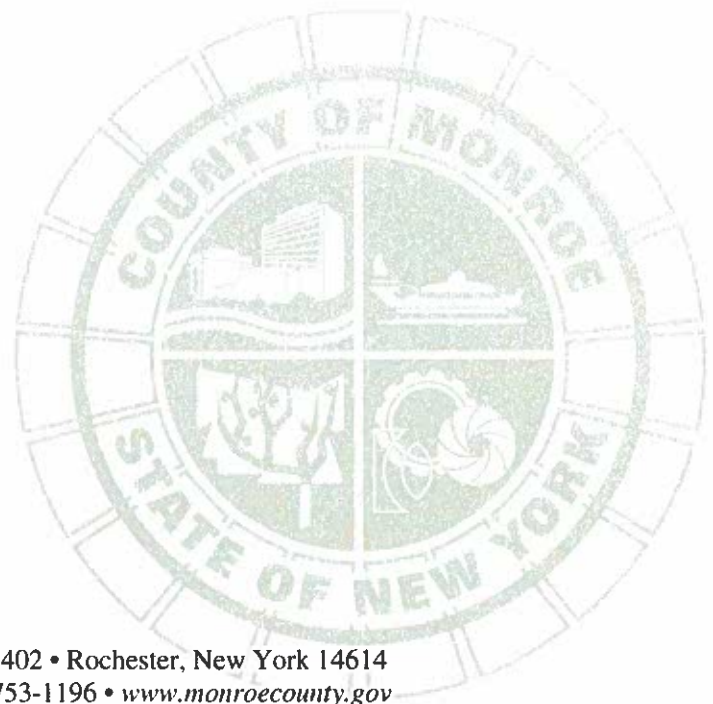

Haley & Aldrich of New York (Haley & Aldrich) has prepared this request for additional funding associated with the consulting services provided for the Long-term Monitoring Program at the Former Brockport Landfill, NYSDEC Site No.8-28-038 located in the Town of Sweden, Monroe County, New York.

In September 2020, Haley & Aldrich entered into an agreement with the Village of Brockport to conduct the periodic groundwater sampling in accordance with the NYSDEC approved plan. To complete the sampling event and subsequent reporting additional tasks beyond the scope of our September 2020 proposal were requested by the NYSDEC.

1. Haley & Aldrich conducted an additional Site visit to evaluate the site conditions for the preparation of the Periodic Monitoring Report.
2. Haley & Aldrich completed a detailed data usability assessment to comply with current requirements of the data management and reporting for the NYSDEC regulated sites.
3. The preparation of Data Usability Summary Reports and the upload of the validated results to the NYSDEC Environmental Site Database.
4. Additional project support activities and communications associated with the preparation of the updated Site Management Plan (that is concurrently being prepared by Leader Environmental).

Haley & Aldrich requests an additional funding of \$7500 for labor and expenses (Task 1) to complete the additional scope of services associated with the project listed above. Services will be provided in accordance with our "Standard Terms and Conditions, 2013" and "Standard Fee Schedule," dated January 2020, designated 20-RS2, provided in our September 2020 proposal.

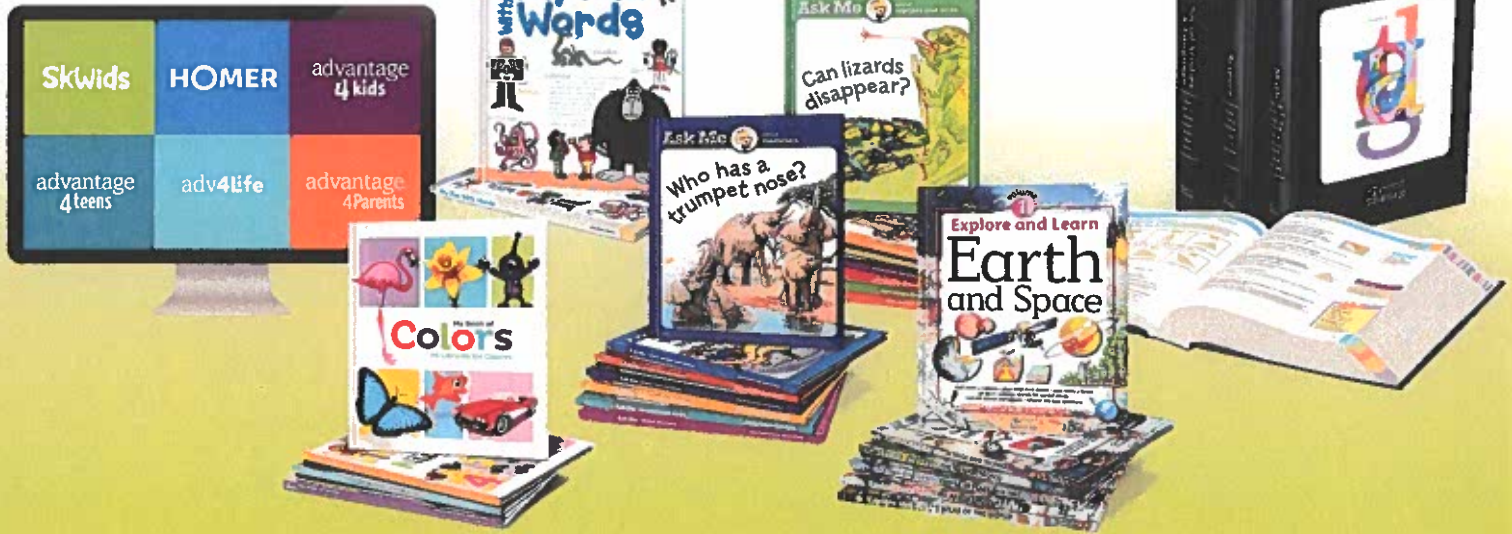

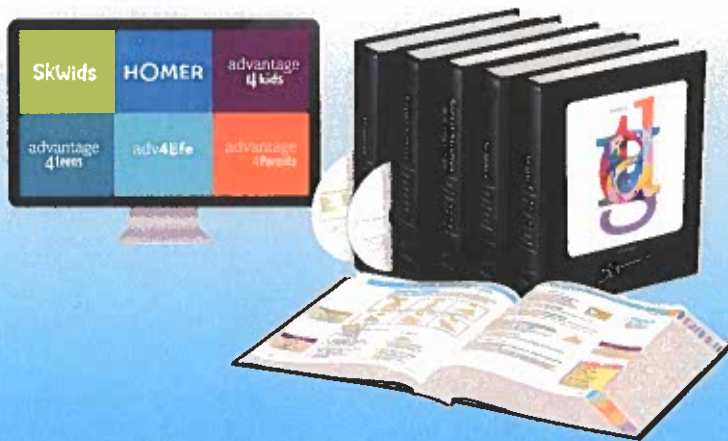

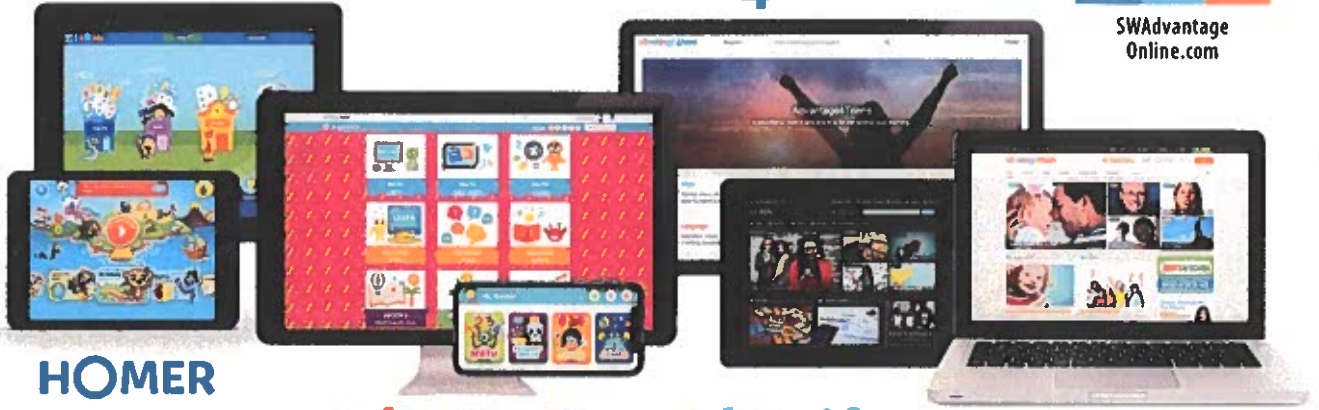
