Chief Cuzzupoli shared his recommendations as to promotions to Lieutenant and Sergeant. Chief Cuzzupoli and Clerk Morelli have consulted with the Village's liaison at Monroe County Human Resources (Civil Service).

→ Trustee Kristansen moved, Trustee LaPierre seconded, carried 5/0 to accept the recommendation of Chief Cuzzupoli and authorize Police Sergeant Stephen J. Mesiti, Jr. for a non-competitive promotional appointment in accordance with Section 52(7) of the New York State Civil Service Law to the title of Police Lieutenant.

The salary change will be effective with the new pay period beginning April 15th. Per the current Stetson Club contract, he will be going from \$87,871.06 to \$97,536.88 and remains eligible for overtime and comp time.

Mayor Blackman signed the memorandum to Monroe County Human Resources to place this request for approval at the May 3rd meeting of the Civil Service Commission.

→ Trustee Kristansen moved, Trustee LaPierre seconded, carried 5/0 to accept the recommendation of Chief Cuzzupoli and authorize Officer Robert W. Hagen for a provisional promotional appointment to the title of Police Sergeant.

The salary change will be effective with the new pay period beginning April 15th. Per the current Stetson Club contract, he will be going from \$77,762.00 to \$87,871.06 and remains eligible for overtime and comp time.

R. Hagen is registered to take the Police Sergeant exam on June 9th.
